

Environmental Policy

Future Biogas is one of the UK's largest producers of biomethane. At the forefront of the anaerobic digestion (AD) industry, Future Biogas is a highly regarded developer and operator of AD plants, providing full asset management service capabilities to a number of blue-chip asset owners. Over the last decade Future Biogas has successfully demonstrated the wide range of benefits to agricultural and food production from integrating biomass for AD into the farming rotation.

Purpose

At Future Biogas we are committed to improving the environmental impact of our activities and leading by example. We are strongly dedicated to respecting our neighbours and to minimising the environmental impact on our surroundings.

Our efforts towards improving the environment will be driven individually and as a team across all areas of the Future Biogas group.

As a business we commit to:

- Meet all of our regulatory requirements as a minimum standard and seek to go above and beyond by achieving additional voluntary standards where reasonably practicable.
- Provide adequate resources to deliver continuous environmental and sustainability improvements.
- Care for all aspects of environmental health including GHG emissions, biodiversity, soil health, air and water quality throughout our operations and supply chain.
- Identify, monitor and seek to reduce our negative impact on the environment notably through compliance with industry best practice across all sites, identifying key environmental risks, and exploring new technologies to optimise performance to:
 - · Prevent accidents to the environment.
 - · Minimise the use of harmful substances.
 - Minimise pollution, including to air, water, and land.
 - Mitigate amenity impact (e.g., complaints arising from odour, noise or light) on neighbours in the local community.

- Minimise waste generated and use of raw materials, including endeavouring to replace use of nonsustainable natural resources.
- Encourage continuous improvement in environmental performance and management systems through setting appropriate targets and audits of compliance against policies and procedures.
- Deliver a positive impact on the environment notably by reducing the UK's GHG emissions, delivering GHG removals, and by improving the quality of its natural resources (e.g., soil health and biodiversity).
- Regularly review environmental improvement targets, track implementation, and monitor accomplishments.
- Be an employer and supplier of choice, by demonstrating best practice in environmental management.
- Implement climate risk-related governance and a climate transition plan informed by regular assessments of physical and transition climate related risks and opportunities to the business
- Demonstrate commitment to the education and development of its staff in relation to environmental matters
- Work with suppliers and wider partners to understand and minimise the impact of their operations on the environment
- Engage with stakeholders, including publishing this policy and information on its environmental performance, including GHG emissions verified by a third party.
- Lead and support the development of AD BECCS (Bioenergy with Carbon Capture and Storage) within the UK, both in terms of practical delivery and policy framework.

Environmental Policy

Who is responsible for this policy?

Overall and final responsibility for environmental compliance performance lies with the Future Biogas Holdco Limited Board (the "Board") who ensures that it is given and retains the highest of priorities.

The Chief Executive Officer has ultimate day to day responsibility for the implementation of this policy and delegates line management responsibility requiring commitment from all employees, consultants and contractors. Specific arrangements and organisational responsibilities are detailed in the Environmental Policy Arrangements as updated with the approval of the Chief Executive Officer on an annual basis.

Who does this apply to?

This Policy applies to Future Biogas Holdco Limited and all its subsidiaries (the "Future Biogas Group"); this means that all employees, contractors, working partners and any subsidiaries

managed by any company in the Future Biogas Group will need to observe and comply with our policy and principles.

Adherence to this policy and associated procedures is a condition of employment for staff of Future Biogas and a condition of engagement for consultants and contractors.

Policy delivery

Each company in the Future Biogas group will follow the policy through an environmental improvement agenda. This should be measured through specific targets. We will communicate our progress through existing staff communications. This will include, but not be limited to:

- How we are complying with the environmental policy
- Our goals and targets in particular in respect of GHG emissions and climate change
- · Current position of improvement plans

Annual Management Review of progress

The Board will review this Environmental Policy at least annually and update it as required, monitoring its implementation on an ongoing basis. If the policy as outlined above is not adhered to and the environmental performance underachieves against the initial expectation, the effectiveness of this environmental policy should be reviewed by management to continue to drive continuous improvements.
